CHARLES BRADY WINS WSOP CIRCUIT RING IN FIRST RECORDED CASH

He collects \$7,791 for his win

Charles Brady just claimed his first Circuit ring in his first recorded tournament cash after outlasting 147 competitors in Event #3: \$250 No-Limit Hold'em (1 Day).

"I've played satellites in Vegas, but never anything like this. I feel incredible, I've won a bunch of cash, and that ring, sure is beautiful," Brady said after his win.

It wasn't an easy ride to victory for Brady. In fact, he was down to one chip a couple of times during the tournament, but he managed to prove that the old poker adage of "a chip and a chair" is true.

"I was down to one chip twice. I was down to 1,400 at Level 7 and I got down to about 2,000 at Level 11. At the final table, I was down to a big blind when there were seven of us left, and now I'm holding the ring."

Brady collected \$7,791 for his win and intends to add another score to his resume.

"I will be here for the Seniors Event tomorrow."
