RUSSELL BOYETTE WINS FIRST CIRCUIT RING IN EVENT#4

He takes home \$8,815 for his victory

Right after getting 14th in Event #2: \$400 No-Limit Hold'em (4 Flights) this afternoon, Boyette didn't waste time and jumped straight in Event #4: \$400 No-Limit Hold'em (1 Day). He managed to be the last man standing of this event, topping his day with a victory and his first Circuit ring.

"I feel good, I felt good all day. After the first event, I just decided last minute to get in this one, it ended up working out good. I've cashed fourteen out of the last eighteen tournaments I've played. It's been a good run," Boyette commented after his victory.

The final table was fast-paced and action-packed. Boyette started the final table with an average stack, but he managed to double up, taking over the chip lead and never really looked back.

"I had ace-king preflop and one of my opponents made an all-in call with king-jack, that pretty much made me chip leader,"

Boyette collected \$8,815, his best live cash to date, for his first-place finish.
