ROBERT CHEUNG WINS THIRD CIRCUIT RING IN EVENT #5

He earns \$9,921 for his victory

Robert Cheung's first visit to Biloxi is off to a good start. He just defeated 107 players in Event #5: \$400 No-Limit Hold'em 6-Handed (1 Day) of the WSOP Circuit at IP Biloxi, collecting \$9,921. This first-place finish adds another ring to his already stacked resume, and he now has three Circuit rings and one WSOP bracelet, with over \$1,245,000 in WSOP cashes.

"I feel good. I love it here. The people and the players here are nice and friendly and the casino is very nice. I'm very impressed with the tournament area. Everyone was laughing, making jokes...having fun is more important than winning a tournament," Cheung commented after his win.

Cheung only plays poker as a hobby, but his poker skills are unquestionable. His victory marks his first cash since the 50th Annual World Series of Poker and he made sure to make it a memorable one.

"I have my business in Vancouver and whenever I can, I love to travel. Since the WSOP in summer this Vegas, I haven't played any tournament. Everything went very smooth today. Everything has to go smooth to win a tournament."

The Canadian businessman intends on going for more this series.

“I will be here for the rest of the tournaments. Now that I have a ring, I have to chase some points.”
