WILLIAM POLLARD IS THE WINNER OF EVENT #6

He wins a Circuit ring in his first recorded victory

William Pollard has just joined the circle of World Series of Poker Circuit winners after navigating through a field of 79 players in Event #6: \$400 Pot-Limit Omaha.

Pollard overcame a tough lineup to take home the \$8,068 first-place prize. The final table was reached on Day 1 and it included multiple WSOP Circuit champions and experienced PLO players. However, Pollard was leading throughout most of it and he kept playing his best game, eventually making it to the final four and returning for the final day.

"They were all very good players. I'm not a huge PLO player, I play mostly Hold'em."

Indeed, this victory marks Pollard's first recorded cash in a Pot-Limit Omaha event, and his first recorded victory.

When the heads-up portion of play started, Pollard was behind, but he put up a good fight, and eventually found a key double up to take over the lead.

"He was ahead quite a bit. But I got lucky in my first double up and kind of grinded it down from there."
