## TRACE HENDERSON SCORES FIRST CIRCUIT GOLD RING

*He collects \$13,382 for his victory* 

Trace Henderson earned his first World Series of Poker title on Tuesday evening at the IP Biloxi Circuit series. He defeated 153 opponents in Event #7: \$400 No-Limit Hold'em 8-Handed (1 Day), winning 13,382 and his first WSOP gold ring.

The poker professional got close to winning a Circuit ring at multiple occasions during his career, including once this series. Just last week, he made it to the final table of Event #1: \$400 No-Limit Hold'em Double Stack (1 Day) but he ended up getting 9<sup>th</sup> for \$1,029.

"I've been close before multiple times, it's good to get one finally. I got hot early, and never looked back. It was a fun run," Henderson said following his win.

When the heads-up match started, Henderson had the lead against Boris Kasabov. Although Kasabov tried his best to turn things around, it was all over when his kings couldn't stay ahead of Henderson's ace-jack in all in preflop situation.

Having already locked up a victory and a final table appearance this series, Henderson climbs near the top of the leaderboard in the Casino champion race.

"That would be cool to win it, I'm going to play everything. If it comes, it comes."
