COREY HARRISON CLAIMS FIRST CIRCUIT RING IN EVENT #9

He defeats Charles Brady heads-up for the title

Bracelet winner Corey Harrison just won his first Circuit ring and \$20,027 in Event #9: \$600 No-Limit Hold'em of the WSOP Circuit at IP Biloxi after navigating through a field of 145 competitors.

Harrison has multiple WSOP Circuit final tables on his resume and he got extremely close to winning a ring at multiple occasions before finally breaking through today. In fact, he made the final table of this event last season but ended up getting ninth.

"It feels great, I've actually been to a few final tables but the cards actually fell my way today, so I was able to make it through. It feels good to finally make it over the top," Harrison said following his win.

Although the tournament was scheduled as a two-day endeavor, the event reached a conclusion in just one. The final table was fast-paced, and action-packed and Harrison ended up defeating Charles Brady heads-up to claim the title.

Brady, who had just won his first Circuit ring a few days ago in his first recorded cash after taking down Event #3: \$250 No-Limit Hold'em (1 day) was going for a second ring in his second Circuit cash. Things were looking good for him as he was dominant for most of the final table, and when the heads-up match got underway, he had a big lead. However, Harrison remained patient and found a shift in cards, to turn things around.

“I was behind quite a bit, but I was pretty patient, and I made a couple of big hands, when he actually had hands. He doubled me up twice. One time he had ace-deuce, I had ace-eight, so that worked out well, and another time we played a really big pot when I turned the nut straight and he had two pair. That was the hand where I got most of my chips,” Harrison commented.

Harrison doesn't plan on wasting time. In fact, he goes back to the grind tomorrow.

“I will play the Main, hopefully only once,” he said jokingly.
