JASON TANG EARNS FIRST WSOP CIRCUIT TITLE

He collects his first Circuit ring and \$11,241

Jason Tang earned his first World Series of Poker Circuit title on Saturday at the IP Biloxi after outmatching 125 players in Event #11: \$400 No-Limit Hold'em (1 Day).

Tang is no stranger at the WSOP Circuit. In fact, he has a track record of multiple final tables, and today, he finally managed to close one out to take home his first Circuit ring, the title, and the top prize of \$11,241.

"First ring, it feels amazing, finally. I have five bubbles, but it finally happened. I checked one off my bucket list, now I need a bracelet."

Tang started the final table with a lower than average stack, but he kept building slowly, then won a three-way all in with aces to take over the lead.

"I chipped up normal, then had some nice spots. I haven't seen aces the whole entire series and I finally got a big hand with aces. That's what really catapulted me at the final table."

During the three-handed portion of play, Tang used his big stack to to apply pressure in the right spots, eliminating Andrew Brinkley in 3rd place then defeating Kataka Eaton heads-up for the title.

Tang plans on returning to the felt this afternoon to take a shot at the \$1,700 Main Event.
