GAVIN MUNROE CLAIMS SECOND CIRCUIT IN EVENT #12

Munroe also collects his second four-figure score of the series

Event #12: \$400 No-Limit Hold'em (1 Day) just wrapped up after 25 levels of play, leaving Gavin Munroe as the last player standing. Munroe earned \$8,615 for his victory, but more importantly, he won his second World Series of Poker Circuit ring.

"It feels good, just busted the Main so had to jump into this. I'm glad to win it," Munroe said following his win.

This is not Munroe's only four-figure cash this series. The 26-year old poker dealer also appeared at the final table of Event #2: \$400 No-Limit Hold'em (4 Flights) but ended up getting fifth for \$9,278. He gave credit to his friends who've helped him improve his game.

"I've been running good, but I think I've been playing better too. I credit all my friends."

The start of heads-up action saw Munroe hold a 2:1 chip advantage over James Payne and it took less than a level for him to win it all.

The latest Circuit winner plans on taking a shot at the series' final event, to try and add a third ring to his collection.

"I guess I will play the Double Stack tomorrow and see if we can get another one."
