### JEFFREY KURTZ WINS CIRCUIT RING IN FIRST WSOP CASH

*He collects \$16,536 for his victory*

Jeffrey Kurtz just added his name to the list of World Series of Poker Circuit champions in his first ever WSOP cash after taking down the opening event of the 2019/2020 Circuit stop at Harrah's Atlantic City, Event #1: \$400 No-Limit Hold'em Double Stack.

He defeated a field of 205 players and collected \$16,536 along with his first ring. His win marks his first ever recorded tournament victory as well as his biggest cash to date.

"It feels good, finally I won a tournament. I ran pretty well," Kurtz said after his victory.

Although Kurtz has a regular day job, he often plays poker and has been around it for eight years. He also has a poker coach who helps him improve his game.

"I've been playing poker for eight years, since I was in college. I play tournaments mainly online on the weekends."

Kurtz came into Day 2 second in chips and managed to keep building, eventually taking a seat at the final table with the second biggest stack. He made it to heads-up with the lead but lost it when John Duci scored a significant double against him in an all in preflop situation. However, Kurtz stayed confident and didn't take long to turn back the tables, claiming the winner title just a couple of hands later.

“I trust myself. I play a lot of poker, I play a lot online. Short-handed play, I’m not worried, especially against live players.”

Kurtz intends on taking a shot at more Circuit events this series.

“I’m going to be here for the whole week.”
