ROBERT CHOW GRABS FOURTH WSOP RING

Robert Chow wins fourth ring after taking down the \$400 H.O.R.S.E event at Bally's Casino.

Robert Chow just took down the \$400 H.O.R.S.E. event at the Bally's Casino World Series of Poker Circuit. Chow won his first WSOP ring back in 2011, and twelve years later he is once again victorious to earn his fourth gold ring.

"It's been a while, and I'm really happy. I have been playing a lot of mixed games and I have been really practicing on my mixed game. So I'm really happy that I got my first ring that is not a hold'em," said the happy winner.

Chow's earned his first ring after winning the \$1,600 Main Event at the Horseshoe Hammond Casino in 2011. The top prize of \$393,583 is still to this day one of the largest cashes in the WSOP Circuit history.

Many years have gone by since his first win, and Chow admits that the game have changed a lot since then.

"The game is tougher across the board nowadays. Everything has got tougher. Way back when, when I started playing, it was always five-six people at the table that did not know that much. Nowadays, you're lucky to find one person that doesn't know how to play. It is harder to play now, and that is why it's more satisfying to actually win it," Chow explained.

The two-day event drew a total of 156 entrants, but only 10 survived to see Day 2. A series of notables were still in the hunt when the final table commenced, including bracelet winners Lawrence Berg and Ron Ware. Berg ended up finishing in 6th place, and Ron Ware busted in 4th for a \$4,058 pay day.

Chow eventually found himself heads-up against Michael Parizon, out of Farmington Hills. The heads-up battle lasted for just under an hour before Chow was able to take it down.

Chow maneuvered a field of 156 entrants to earn \$51,480 and his fourth WSOP Circuit gold ring. He also earns a seat in the Tournament of Champions, held in Las Vegas in the summer of 2022.
