Players begin with 4,500 in Tournament Chips. All levels will last 60 minutes. Breaks will occur after every two levels and last 20 minutes. Dinner break on Day 1 will be after the completion of level 6 and last 90 minutes. There will be a 60 minute break on subsequent playing days after the completion of 4 levels. Play will continue on Day 1 until the completion of level 10. Day 2: play will resume at 2:30 PM and continue down to the final table or the completion of 10 levels, whichever comes first. Day 3: play will resume at 2:30 PM, and continue until a winner has been determined. If an event is running long, the tournament director reserves the right to suspend play after the completion of 10 levels and resume the following day. 7% of the total entry pool will be withheld for entry fees, and 3% of the total entry pool will be withheld for tournament staff.
