- **\$1,700 buy-in** (\$1,515 prize pool + \$185 administrative fee). Fee includes any and all staffing / dealer fees, add-ons and rake.
- Players will start with **30,000 in tournament chips**. Players may choose to start on any flight. Players may re-enter one time per flight.
- Registration will remain open until the start of level 13, eliminated players may re-enter until this time. All original fees apply. Players must have zero (0) chips remaining to re-enter or be subject to disqualification. Players may forfeit their current stack to re-enter.
- Any player who has not taken a hand by the first break may be considered a "no show" and may have their chips removed from play and may not be eligible to participate and may not be eligible for a refund.
- This tournament is scheduled as three-day tournament. The Tournament Director in his sole and absolute discretion may adjust the break schedule, adjust the start and stop time, adjust the level lengths, and/or add an additional day if necessary.
- There will be a 15-minute break for every 2 hours of play.
- Day 1 flights will play until the completion of level 16 OR approximately 12% of the field.
- All Flights will merge for Day 2 on Sunday, March 24<sup>th</sup> at 12:00 PM and play down to a final table or until the completion of level 27.
- Day 3 will resume at 12:00 PM on Monday, March 25<sup>th</sup> and play to conclusion.
- Winner receives a WSOP Circuit Ring and will qualify to earn points for the WSOP Global Casino Championship.
