>PLAYERS WILL START WITH 15,000 IN TOURNAMENT CHIPS

>PLAYERS ELIMINATED FROM A FLIGHT MAY RE-ENTER A LATER FLIGHT OR THE SAME FLIGHT IF REGISTRATION IS STILL OPEN.

>PLAYERS MAY SURRENDER THEIR CHIPS AT THE END OF FLIGHT A IF THEY WISH TO ENTER FLIGHT B

>BOTH FLIGHTS WILL MERGE AT 12 PM ON SEPTEMBER 18, 2022. IN THE EVENT THE FINAL TABLE IS UNABLE TO REACH A CONCLUSION AS SCHEDULED, THE TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR IN HIS SOLE AND ABSOLUTE DISCRETION MAY ADD A DAY 3 IF NECESSARY

>A MAXIMUM OF 300 PLAYERS MAY PARTICIPATE AT THE START OF THE TOURNAMENT. IF MORE THAN 300 WISH TO PARTICIPATE, ALTERNATES WILL BE ACCEPTED UNTIL THE END OF LEVEL 8 FOR ALL FLIGHTS

>REGISTRATION IS OPEN UNTIL THE START OF LEVEL 9 FOR ALL FLIGHTS.

>EACH FLIGHT WILL HAVE PAYOUT STARTING WHEN THERE IS APPROXIMATELY 15 % OF THE FIELD FOR THAT FLIGHT REMAINING. PAYOUTS WILL BE BASED ON THE NUMBER OF ENTRIES FOR OR THAT SPECIFIC FLIGHT. PLAY WILL CONTINUE FOR EACH FLIGHT UNTIL THERE IS APPROXIMATELY 10% OF THE FIELD REMAINING OR WHEN THE CURRENT PAYOUT FROM THAT FLIGHT IS CLOSEST TO THE HIGHEST PAYOUT FROM PREVIOUS FLIGHTS. AT THAT POINT THE REMAINING PLAYERS WILL BAG THEIR CHIPS AND RETURN FOR DAY 2. IF AT THE END OF PLAY FOR A FLIGHT, A PLAYER WISHES TO SURRENDER THEIR CHIPS, THEY MAY DO SO AND THEY WILL RECEIVE THE SAME PAYOUT AS THE LAST PLAYER ELIMINATED FOR THAT FLIGHT. PLAYERS MAY PLAY IN MULTIPLE FLIGHTS, BUT ONCE THEY HAVE BAGGED CHIPS IN A FLIGHT THEY MAY NOT PLAY IN SUBSEQUENT FLIGHTS.

>AFTER THE END OF THE LAST FLIGHT, THE PRIZE POOLS FROM EACH FLIGHT WILL BE COMBINED AND THE PRIZE MONEY ALREADY PAID OUT WILL BE SUBTRACTED. THE APPROVED WSOP PAYOUT TABLE WILL BE USED TO DETERMINE THE PAYOUTS FOR THE REMAINING PRIZE POOL BASED ON THE NUMBER OF PLAYERS THAT BAGGED FOR DAY 2. THIS CALCULATION MAY RESULT IN SOME PLACES BEING A LOWER VALUE THAN THE HIGHEST PAYOUT FROM THE INDIVIDUAL FLIGHTS. IF THAT IS THE CASE, ALL PLACES THAT ARE BELOW THE HIGHEST PAYOUT OF THE FLIGHTS WILL BE INCREASED TO MATCH THE HIGHEST PAYOUT FROM THE FLIGHTS. WHATEVER AMOUNT IS NEEDED TO INCREASE THOSE PAYOUTS WILL BE DEDUCTED FROM THE REMAINING SPOTS BASED ON THE PAYOUT PERCENTAGES FOR THOSE REMAINING SPOTS.

>FOR EXAMPLE, IF 60 PLAYERS RETURN FOR DAY 2 AND AFTER CALCULATING THE PAYOUTS BASED ON THE REMAINING PRIZE POOL AND THE REMAINING PLAYERS, THE PAYOUTS FOR PLACES 56-60 ARE CALCULATED AT \$600 AND THE HIGHEST PAYOUT FROM THE INDIVIDUAL FLIGHTS WAS \$640, THEN THE PAYOUTS FOR PLACES 56-60 WOULD BE INCREASED TO \$640. THAT WOULD RESULT IN \$200 THAT WOULD BE DEDUCTED FROM THE REMAINING PRIZE POOL AND PLACES 1-55 WOULD BE PAID BASED APPROVED PAYOUT PERCENTAGES OF THE REMAINING PRIZE POOL.
