Tournament Rules:

- 30,000 tournament chips.
- 30-minute levels 1-23. Levels 24+ will last 45 minutes.
- This is a 2-day event. Day 1 will play 18 levels or final table whichever comes first. Day 2 will resume Monday, August 14, 2023, and play to a completion.
- A single ante will be paid from the big blind for each hand. The ante is paid after the big blind. The ante will not reduce.
- Breaks will be approximately every 4 levels.
- On-Site Registration and Re-Entry are available until the start of Level 13 of this event. Approximately 10:45pm.
- An eliminated player may Re-Enter the event. Alternates and late sign-ups will enter the tournament with a full chip stack and no obligation from it.
- Seating may be limited for this event.
- WSOP rules apply. Tournament Director's decisions are final.
- Management reserves the right to alter, change, or cancel this tournament. Management will not be held responsible in the event of typographical errors or misinformation on the website or printed material pertaining to this event.
- Redraw at 27, 18, and 10 players or at Tournament Director's discretion.
- Winners will be paid in casino chips.
- All tax laws foreign and domestic apply. Winners must show a valid ID to collect winnings. Residents of foreign countries without a U.S. tax treaty will be subject to withholding. Pursuant to new IRS regulations, W-2G or 1042 forms will be issued for all tournament winnings of \$5,000 or more (net of buy-in amount).
- \$1,000 will go to the prize pool. \$125 will go toward administrative fee. Administrative fee includes all staffing/dealer fees, and rake.
